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## **SPECIALTY CLASSIFICATION • NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

#### **VETERAN DOG CLASS**

#### **VETERAN BITCH CLASS**

For Doberman Pinscher Dogs and Bitches seven (7) years of age and older.

First Place winners of the Veteran Dog Class and Veteran Bitch Class are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed Competition, if otherwise undefeated at this specialty show. Ribbon prizes will be awarded for first through fourth place in each Veteran Class.

**Note** - Chapter 11, Section 8, of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, provides that neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at Independent Breed Specialties.

#### **BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES**

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## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP**

**JUDGE: MRS. SARA L. KARL**

Entry Fee: \$10.00 for Junior Showmanship only, or as an additional entry of the same dog. Each Doberman Pinscher entered in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the breed classes at this show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. An eligible Doberman Pinscher, other than the one entered, may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. The Junior must have the AKC number of the substitute Doberman Pinscher. All such substitutions must be made at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. A Junior is limited to one substitution at a show. EACH Doberman Pinscher exhibited in Junior Showmanship must be owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations, or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Each Doberman Pinscher entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO ENTER. A Doberman Pinscher that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of other dogs at the show, or the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

### **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSIFICATION**

**NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS** - This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - This class is the same as the Novice Junior Class except it shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 and under 15 years old on the day of the show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS** - This class is the same as the Novice Junior Class except it shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 and under 18 years old on the day of the show

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS** - This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of each Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the corresponding Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3rd) first place award with competition and further provided there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the corresponding Open Class.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - This class is the same as the Open Junior Class except it shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 and under 15 years old on the day of the show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS** - This class is the same as the Open Junior Class except it shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

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## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (Continued)**

**BEST JUNIOR HANDLER** - The Junior Handlers placing first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at this show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for Best Junior Handler. There must be competition for this award, with a minimum of two class winners present to compete.

**NOTE** - Junior Handlers who win a third (3rd) Novice Class, with competition present, after the closing of entries for this show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class, provided that this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at this show.

**NOTICE** - Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. A Junior Handler Number may be obtained by contacting the American Kennel Club. Phone: (919) 816-3776. Email: juniors@akc.org.

**Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship is entered on both front and back of the Official AKC Entry Form.**

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## **PUPPY/JUNIOR SWEEPSTAKES**

**JUDGE: MR. HOWARD (BUTCH) ENGEL**

**ENTRY FEE:** \$18.00 for each Puppy or Junior entered in the Sweepstakes.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The Puppy/Junior Sweepstakes is open to all Doberman Pinschers that are at least six (6) months of age, and under eighteen (18) months of age, on the day of the show. All dogs entered in the Puppy/Junior Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in one of the Regular Breed Classes at this Specialty Show, at the regular class entry fee. Entries must be on the standard Official American Kennel Club Entry Form, with "Sweepstakes" and the age division marked in the "additional Classes" space.

**NOTE** - Doberman Pinschers born on, or after, August 17, 2005, and those born on, or before, August 16, 2004, are NOT ELIGIBLE to be entered in this Sweepstakes.

**ENTRIES CLOSE: 12:00 NOON, WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 1, 2006.**

Entries must be received at the Show Secretary's office, and cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after time and date of closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6, of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.

**NOTE** - The Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class is an adult Regular Class and requires an entry fee of \$22.00.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS, OR CORRECTIONS to entries already received **MUST** be in writing, delivered by: hand, mail, express service, email, telegram, or facsimile, and received prior to the time and date of closing. Changes cannot be made by telephone.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon after the closing date as practicable. If not received in a reasonable time, please notify Robert Miller at (303) 278-8384.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors, entering the same dog twice, cancellation of entries after the published time of closing; nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Doberman Pinscher Club of the Rocky Mountain Area, Inc., it is impossible to complete this event, no refund of entry fees will be made.

**DPCRMA SPECIALTY SCHEDULE OF JUDGING:** Puppy/Junior Sweepstakes judging will start at 4:00 pm, with Regular Breed Class judging to follow immediately thereafter. Junior Showmanship will be judged just prior to Best of Breed judging. Every effort will be made to follow this schedule, however, this scheduling is subject to changes.

**DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

**DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW** only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. The show site will be available to exhibitors from noon to 4:00 pm on Wednesday, February 15, 2006, and from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm on Thursday, February 16, 2006. The site will again be available from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm on Friday, February 17, 2006, through Monday, February 20, 2006. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following the Best in Show judging on Monday, February 20, 2006.
