AKC FEES: "A RECORDING FEE OF \$.50 AND AN EVENT SERVICE FEE OF \$1.50

will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club Show or Obedience Trial. Fees are to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, fees are to be collected on the first entry only." *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2*

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED:

- In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee
- For duplicate entries
- If the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club or show secretary.

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with International Money Orders guaranteed in U.S. Funds.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. Entries not on OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS (or photocopies of same which do not include the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side) are not acceptable.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, by fax, telegram or e-mail **JDC_ShowSecretary@msn.com** prior to close of entries. Those received verbally by telephone are not acceptable.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no person shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO DOUBLE HANDLING will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

There is no space provided for unentered dogs. Puppies and dogs not entered in this show are not permitted on the show grounds.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be picked up at the show, none will be mailed. All awards will be made in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the rightful winner of the award.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males **may be entered** in the Veteran Dog Class(s) and spayed females **may be entered** in the Veteran Bitch Class(s) at independent specialties only.

NOTE: 1st Place winners of Veteran Dog / Bitch Classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed **IF** undefeated in any other class at this show.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NOTE: Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a *Championship* after Closing of Entries for this show, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the *Regular Classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition*, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of judging at this show. (Chapter 11, Section 6, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*)

BROOD BITCH CLASS

same as for the stud dog *except* substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males **may be entered** as Stud Dog and spayed females **may be entered** as Brood Bitch.

NOTE: As the judges decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes is based upon the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have not won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS for boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have not won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have not won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS for boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

The winner of a third first place in each Novice Class shall automatically become eligible to enter the corresponding Open Class at the show, provided the win is the third first place with competition and further provided there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in that Open Class.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered and shown in one of the breed or obedience classes at the show, or must be entered for JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season, or a veterinarian's excuse, may be replaced by another dog meeting the below ownership requirements. Such substitution must be requested in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an Official AKC Entry Form. All such requests must be made one-half hour prior to the judging of any Regular Classes at the show.

Each dog must be owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations, or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. **Bitches in season are not eligible. At a Specialty Show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.**

A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a breed judge, or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused by a veterinarian for the protection of other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Entries for regular Junior Showmanship Classes shall close at the same time that entries close for this show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their **AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER** on each entry.

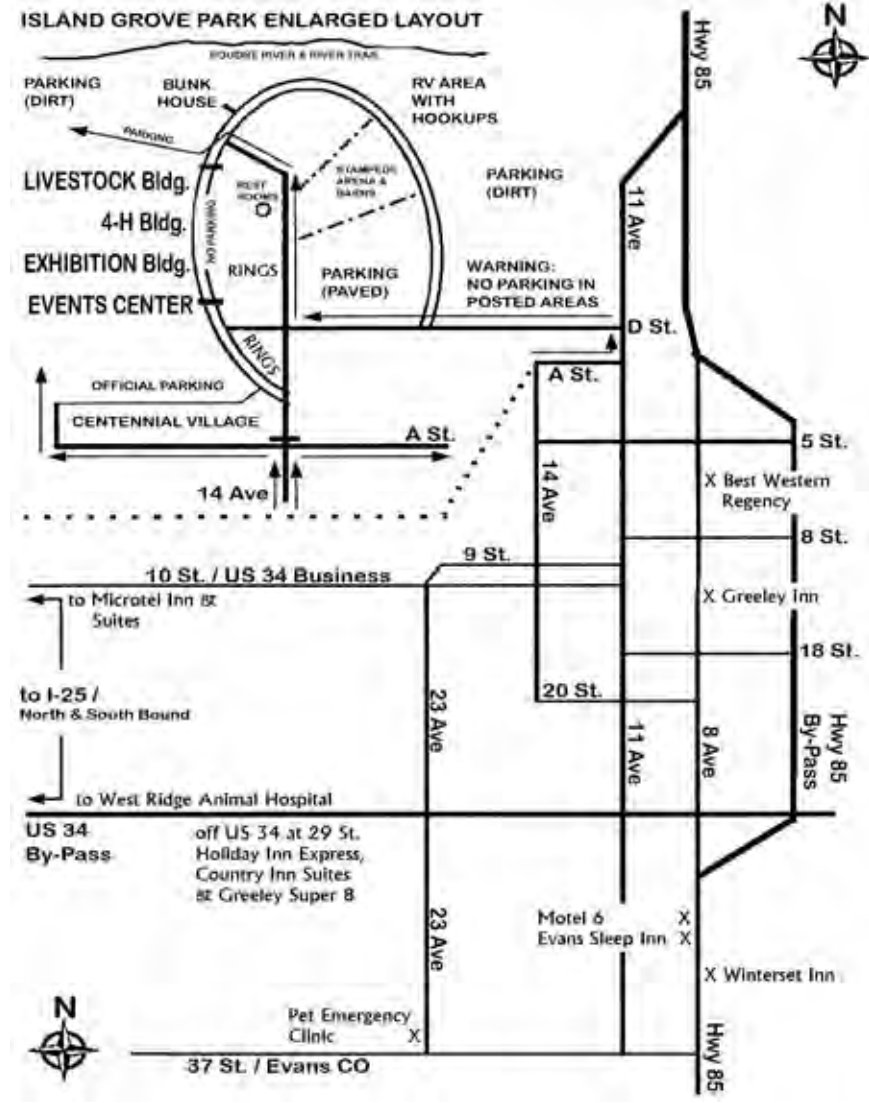
